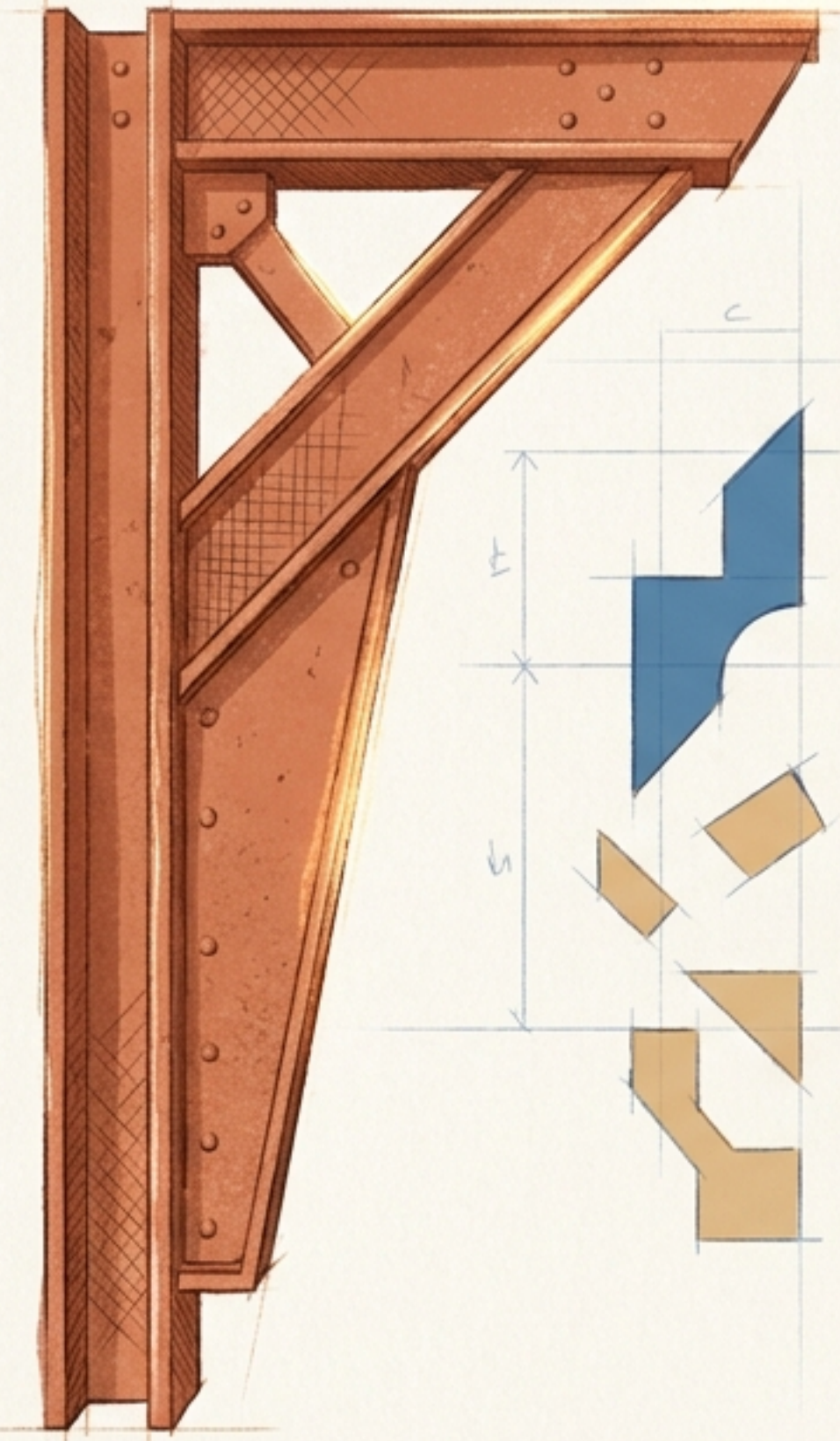

Where children gather, responsibility must follow.

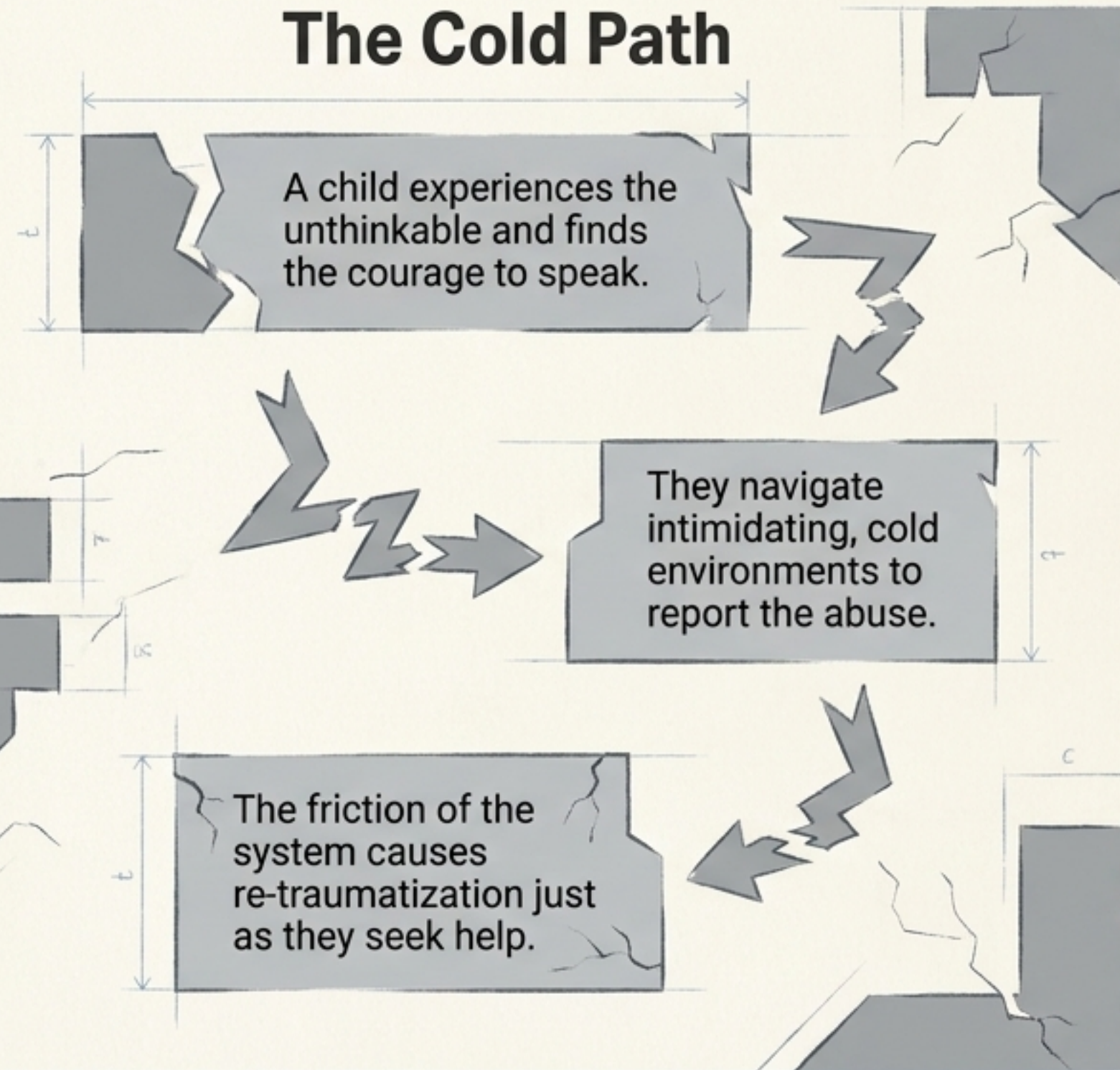
Safe environments for our children do not happen by chance. They are built intentionally by people and institutions willing to take responsibility.

Our mission is to transform the landscape of child protection from a series of reactive moments into a robust, proactive system.

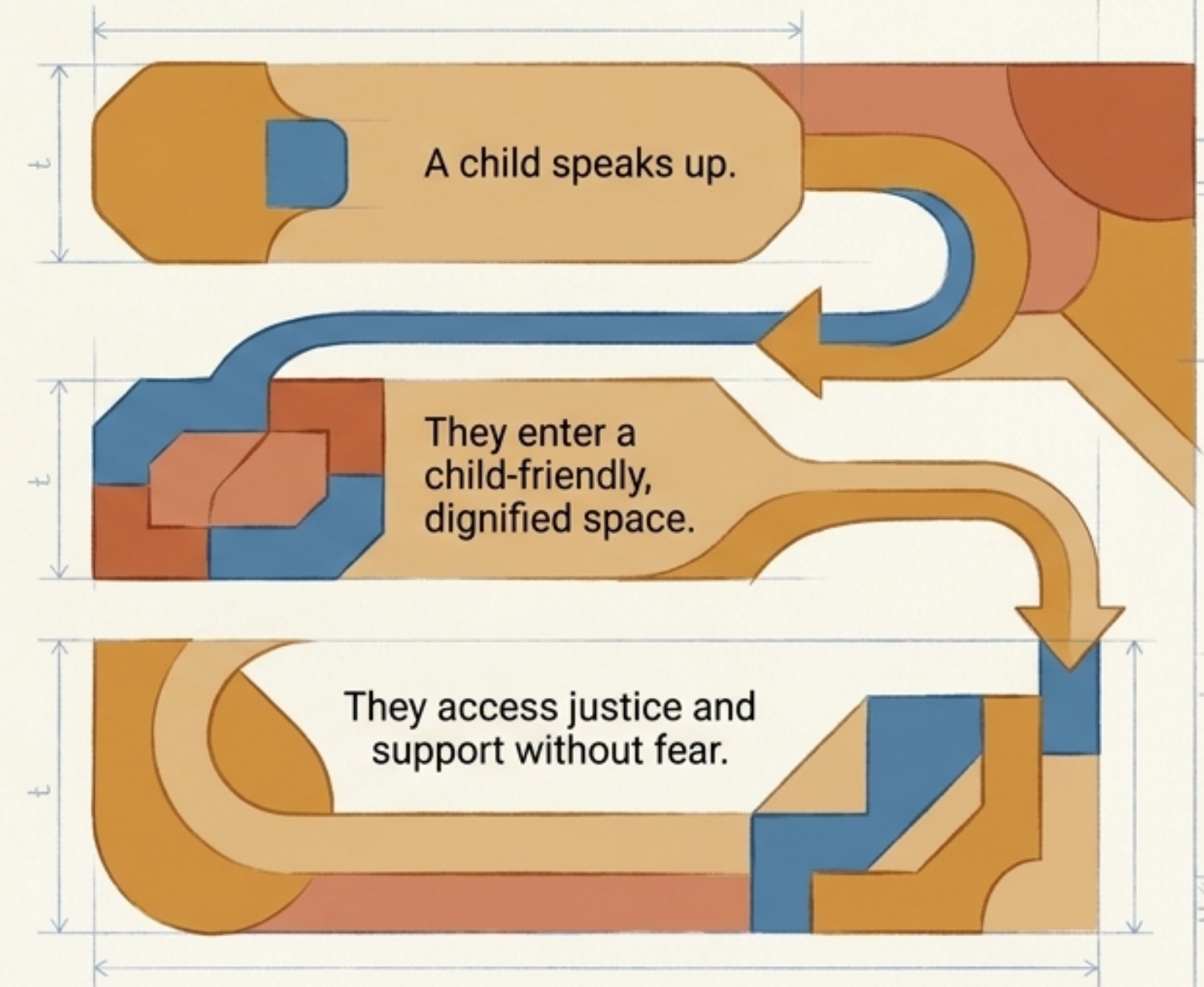

Dimension	Accidental Safety (The Status Quo)	Intentional Safety (Enkerai Sidai)

Behavior Management	Traditional punishment	Responsive guidance and understanding
Community Role	Passive bystanders	Active, celebrated champions

These are not isolated projects. They are interlocking structures that span law enforcement, education, and community leadership to create a comprehensive safety net.

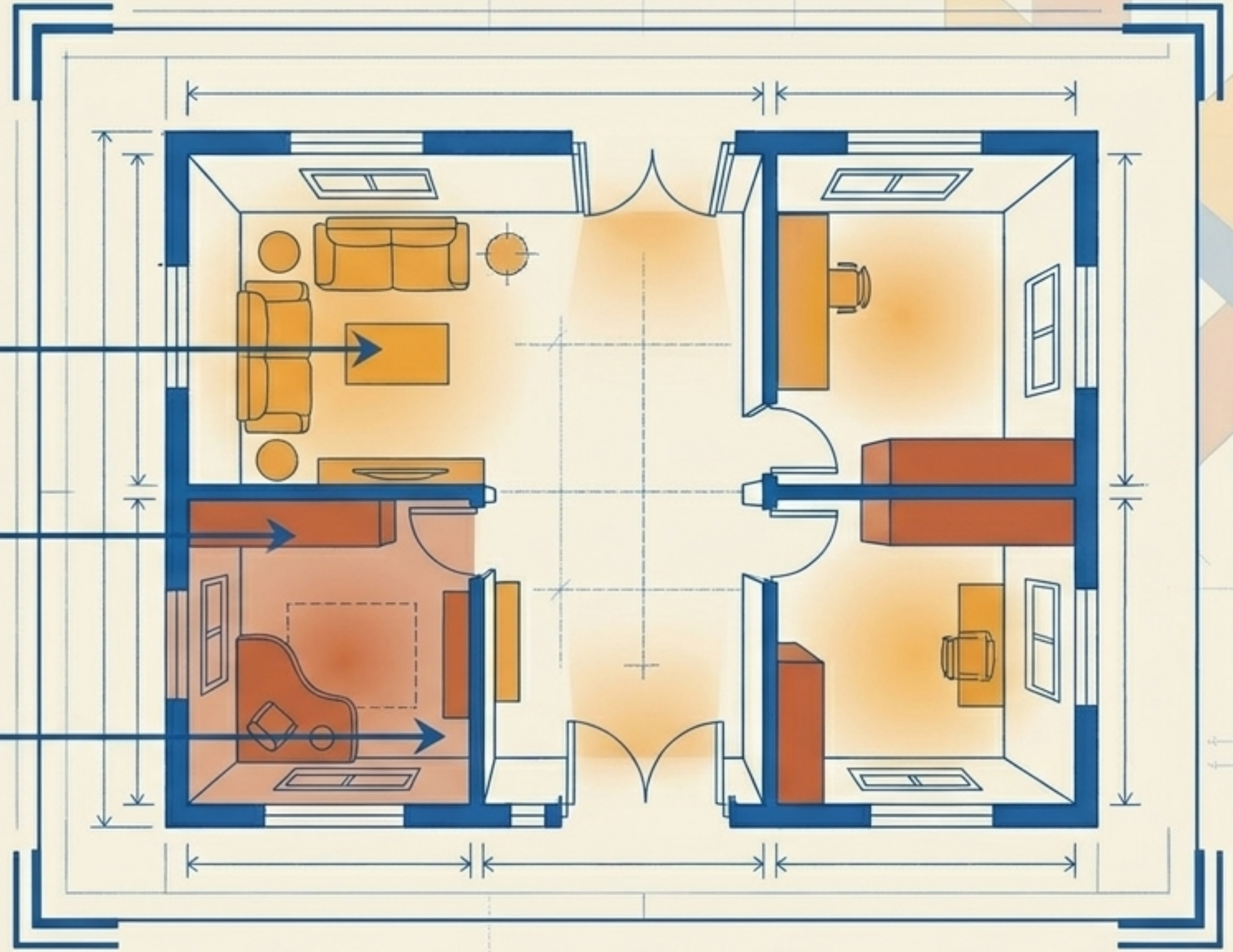
Pillar 1: A Sanctuary for Justice

Dignified Space: Moving away from cold, intimidating police environments.

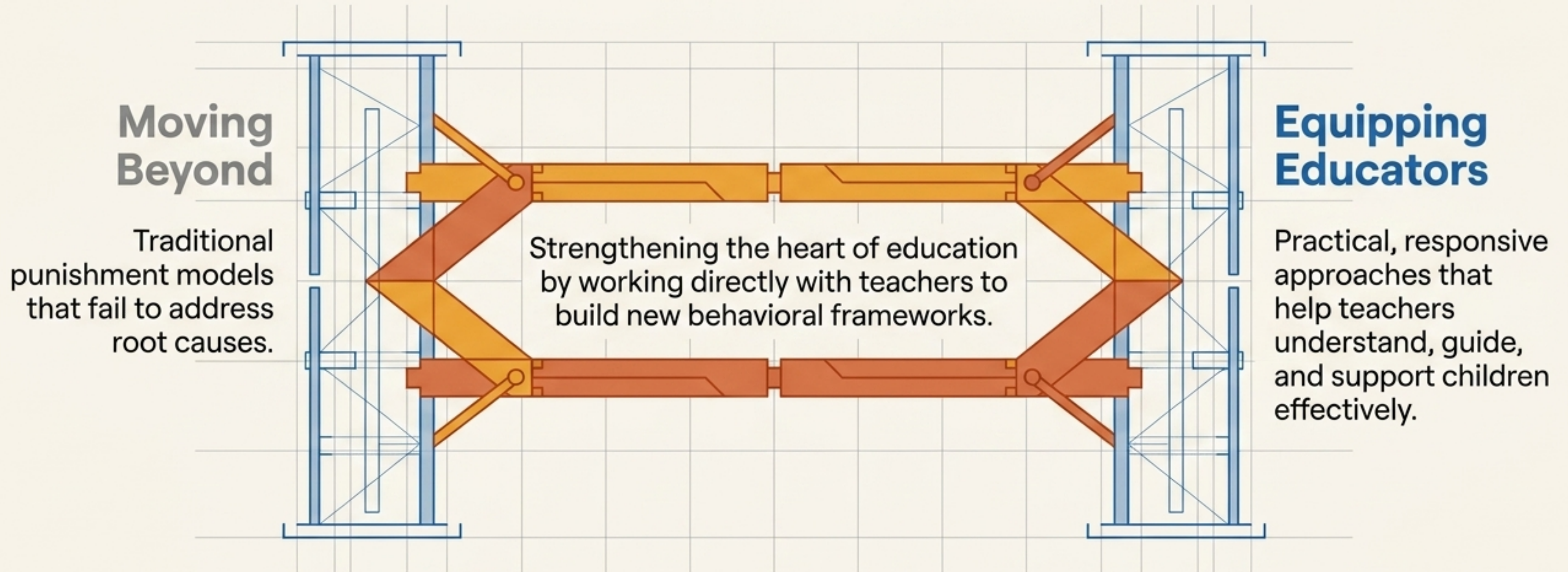
Psychological Safety: Designed specifically so children can report cases without fear.

The Child Protection Awards.

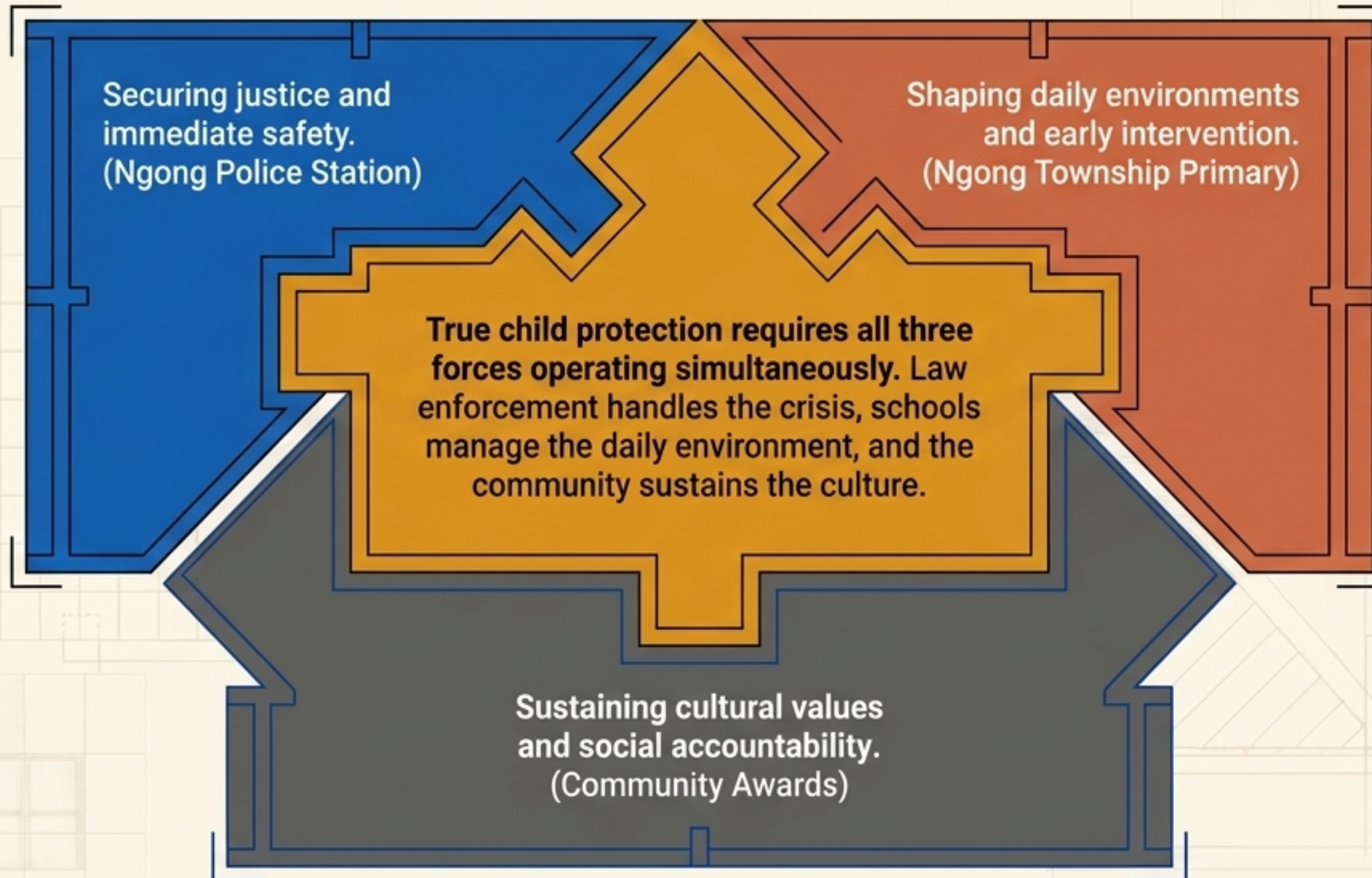
Safety only becomes a permanent community value when it is actively celebrated.
